#### I. Audit Services Contract Two-Year Extension

- Staff provided information about the audit services contract including the proposed 2.9% price adjustment for the next two fiscal years.
- Jonathan Foster of the audit firm Davis Farr LLP gave a presentation about the role of auditors as it relates to the District.
  - Mr. Foster explained how auditors maintain independence from the District.
  - Mr. Foster discussed the auditors' relationship to the Board and how they interact with staff.
  - Lastly, he emphasized the importance of internal controls in the audit process and how internal controls can help improve work quality and prevent fraud.
- The Committee moved the contract forward to the full Board for review and approval. Mr. Foster left the meeting at approximately 10:15 am.

#### 2. Mid-Year Financial Results Report

- Staff provided a detailed report on the financial results of District operations for the six months ended December 31, 2019.
  - The report included discussion of the District's success in utilizing the MWD Dry Year Yield program.
    - i. The District has produced about 13,400 acre-feet of groundwater from the MWD storage account in Chino Basin.
  - While water usage is about 5% under the projections, the District has kept operating expenses to 5% under budget for the six-month time period.
