Introductory Remarks by Chair Cetina

Chair Cetina announced for the record that this meeting was conducted by teleconference pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-2-1 in response to the COVID-19 State of Emergency. Further, the agenda stated that there was no public location for attending this meeting in person. The agenda stated that the public may listen and provide comment telephonically by calling the number listed on the agenda. Chair Cetina took a roll call of Committee members and staff present on the call as listed above.

1. Education and Outreach Update (Verbal)

- Staff provided an update on social media activity, community outreach efforts, and events. Spring is an active season for the GPA Department and customers will have numerous opportunities to participate in raffles, giveaways, rebates, programs, and events.

2. Water Awareness Month (Verbal)

- CVWD will recognize May as Water Awareness Month. Staff will present a proclamation dedicated to all CVWD customers at the May 10 Board Meeting.

3. MWD Water Supply Update (Verbal)

- Staff provided an update on MWD's water shortage emergency condition. The MWD Board will consider an optional approach to one day per week outdoor watering. The alternative option would be based on MWD providing an allocation of water to State Water Project (SWP) dependent areas which have their own unique local supplies in addition to SWP water. Staff will continue to coordinate with IEUA and MWD on this critical issue.
